Effective Questioning Effective questioning supports learning.	 □ Questions are: intentional (for all levels of questioning) linked to the curriculum/big ideas constructed to allow for multiple responses criteria based provocative/challenging to answer invite students to apply their understanding and connect to personal experiences invite students to reflect upon their ideas and beliefs encourage student self-reflection and reflection upon peers' ideas to respond □ Appropriate wait time is used □ Student responses are gathered in a variety of ways (e.g., ActiVotes, Plickers, random name generators, think-pair-share, whiteboards, stoplights, etc.) □ Students are taught and encouraged to ask powerful thinking questions □ Students respond to each other's ideas, rather than just to the teacher's ideas.
