I Can statements, put outcomes into own words, etc.) <input type="checkbox"/> Students are asked to talk about their ideas and previous experiences related to the learning outcomes. <input type="checkbox"/> Criteria is shared or co-created <input type="checkbox"/> Assessment tools (exemplars, anecdotal feedback, checklist, checkbric, rubric) help students understand outcomes <input type="checkbox"/> Students understand and explain what they do well and take steps to improve.
